

# Scottsdale High School

## School Uniform Code Year 7 - 10



Ratified by School Association October 2015

The pupils, parents, staff and Scottsdale High School Association strongly support the wearing of school uniform. This promotes a sense of pride in the school and reduces fashion competitions etc. Parents will be informed when any change is made.

**The following school uniform is recommended:**

**Girls:** Shirt style dress in red, green and white small check  
Tartan skirt (winter)  
Tailored black shorts (just above or below the knee), black trousers/black jeans – (not leggings or blue denim jeans)  
School green and gold polo top or biscuit coloured shirt  
Green 'v' neck woollen school jumper, plain green polar fleece jumper, school rugby jumper, school jacket light weight, winter weight or puffer.  
White, green or black socks; black stockings  
Black shoes

**Boys:** Black trousers or shorts  
Biscuit coloured shirt or school green and gold polo top  
Green 'v' neck woollen school jumper, plain green polar fleece jumper, school rugby jumper, school jacket light weight, winter weight or puffer.  
Grey, white or black socks  
Black shoes

**Footwear note:** Footwear to meet Workplace Health and Safety guidelines, i.e. must be covered footwear, not sandals thongs, ugg boots or slippers. If unacceptable footwear is worn students may be excluded from practical classes.

**School Jackets Rugby Jumper Polo Top:** There are three types of jackets: winter weight which is waterproof and lined with polar fleece, light weight is polyester/cotton lined and showerproof, and a black puffer jacket which has polyester lining and outer. The rugby jumper is green, red and gold and the green and gold polo top is made from micro mesh. All these school uniform items have Scottsdale High School embroidered on them and are available to purchase from the school office.

**Sport Uniform:** When representing the school, students are to wear plain black track pants, or plain black sports shorts, school green and gold polo top, plain green polar fleece jumper, or school jacket. A t-shirt in your house colour is advisable for swimming, cross-country and athletics carnivals.

**Jewellery:** Acceptable jewellery for school is as follows:

- A simple neck chain with optional small pendant
- A watch
- A maximum of two plain sleepers or studs per ear lobe
- A simple ID bracelet or ID necklace
- One simple style ring
- A small nose stud (to be taped if a teacher requests for particular classes)

**Facial Jewellery:** For health and safety reasons students are not to wear facial jewellery at school (except a small nose stud).

**Jewellery:** Approved retainers may be worn. Tape may be worn to cover jewellery but the school will take no responsibility if an injury occurs.

**It is not acceptable to wear:**

- Long sleeved shirts or t-shirts under school shirt. If students feel cold and wish to wear extra layers, these need to be worn underneath the school jumpers or jackets.

Students who consistently choose not to wear the school uniform will forfeit the opportunity to participate in extra curricular activities. This action is supported by our School Association.
